DISCUSSION:

The Director (Dev. & Finance), DG Khan apprised the house that the Deputy 21. Director (Development), Mužaffargarh vide her office letter No.DD(DEV)/598 dated 24.11.2022 has submitted the dully vetted PC-I / rough cost estimate of development scheme namely "Improvement and Construction of Concrete Pavers in Kot Addu City" amounting to Rs.133.550 million under Punjab Cities Program (PCP) pertaining to District Muzaffargarh for consideration / administrative approval by the Divisional Development Working Party (DDWP). The Deputy Commissioner, Muzaffargarh briefed the house that the Punjab Cities Program is a World Bank Funded Program with a total cost of USD 236.000 million. The Project is being funded by World Bank as Donor alongwith 20% cofinancing from the Program Units and is not proposed to be financed out of block allocation. The Project aims at improvement of infrastructure of Municipal Services such as roads, cross roads, street lights, parks and parking shed for SWM machinery for improved communication and recreational facilities. The Chief Officer, Municipal Committee, Kot Addu further briefed the house about the detail of scope of work and stated that the scheme is feasible, in public interest & fulfill the sectoral criteria laid down by the Government & the detail of scheme is given as under:-

1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 General

With 110 million inhabitants (census 2017), Punjab is by far the most populated province in Pakistan. Punjab is Pakistan's second largest province by area after Baluchistan with an area of 205,344 square kilometers (79,284 square miles). It occupies 25.8% of the total landmass of Pakistan. Punjab has nine divisions as shown in map below and 36 districts.

The Punjab Cities Program (PCP), is a World Bank-funded hybrid of Program for Results (P for R) and Investment Project Financing (IPF) operation, with total cost of USD 200 million over 5 years (2018 -2023) supporting 16 cities in Punjab. Its development objective is to strengthen the performance of participating Municipal Committees/Corporations (MCs), focusing on urban management and improvement of municipal infrastructure for satisfactory service delivery.







11.1 The Bid shall comprise two envelopes submitted simultaneously, one called the Technical Bid and the other the Price Bid, containing the documents listed in Bidding Data Sheet under the heading of IB 11.1 A & B respectively. Both envelopes to be enclosed together in an outer single envelope called the Bid. Each bidder shall furnish all the documents as specified in Bidding Data Sheet 11.1 A& B



- partners. Alternatively, a Letter of Intent to execute a Joint Venture Agreement in the count of a successful bid shall be signed by all partners and submitted with the bid, together with a copy of the proposed agreement. The role to be played by each partner to be specified therein. Bids submitted by a joint venture of two (2) or more firms shall comply with the following requirements:-
 - In case of a successful bid, the Form of JV Agreement shall be signed so as to be legally binding on all partners within 7 days of the receipt of letter of acceptance.
 - One of the joint venture partners shall be nominated as being in charge; and this authorization shall be evidenced by submitting a power of attorney signed by legally authorized signatories of all the joint venture partners;
 - The partner-in-charge shall always be duly authorized to deal with the Employer regarding all matters related with and/or incidental to the execution of Works as per the terms and Conditions of JV Agreement and in this regard to incur any and all liabilities, receive instructions, give binding undertakings and receive payments on behalf of the joint venture;
 - All partners of the joint venture shall at all times and under all circumstances be liable jointly and severally for the execution of the Contract in accordance with the Contract terms and a statement to this effect shall be included in the authorization mentioned under Sub-Para (b) above as well as in the Form of Bid and in the Form of JV Agreement (in case of a successful bid); and
 - A copy of JV agreement shall be submitted before signing of the Contract, stating the conditions under which JV will function, its period of duration, the persons authorized to represent and obligate it and which persons will be directly responsible for due performance of the Contract and can give valid receipts on behalf of the joint venture, the proportionate participation of the several firms forming the joint venture, and any other information necessary to permit a full appraisal of its functioning. The JV Agreement shall be made part of the contract. No amendments / modifications whatsoever in the joint venture agreement shall be agreed to between the joint venture partners without prior written consent of the Employer
- The Bidder shall furnish, as part of the Technical Bid, a Technical Proposal including a statement of work methods, equipment, personnel, schedule and any other information as stipulated Bidding Forms, in sufficient detail to demonstrate the adequacy of the Bidders' proposal to meet the work requirements and the completion time referred to in Sub-Clause 1.2 hereof.

B.12 Bid Prices

- Unless stated otherwise in the Bid Documents, the Contract shall be for the whole of the Works as described in IB 1.1 hereof, based on the unit rates and / or prices submitted by the Bidder.
- The Bidders shall fill in rates and prices for all items of the Works described in the Bill of Quantities. Items against which no rate or price is entered by a Bidder will not be paid for by the Employer when executed and shall be deemed covered by rates and prices for other items in the Bill of Quantities.

All duties, taxes and other levies payable by the Contractor under the Contract, or for any other cause, as on the date 28 days prior to the deadline for submission of Bids shall be included in the rates and prices and the total Bid Price submitted by a Bidder.

EXECUTE Currencies of Bid and Payment

The unit rates and the prices shall be quoted by the bidder entirely in Pak rupees only.

B 14 Bid Validity

- Bids shall remain valid for the period stipulated in the Bidding Data Sheet after the Date of Bid Opening specified in sub-clause IB.23.
- In exceptional circumstances, prior to expiry of the original Bid validity period, the Employer may request that the Bidders extend the period of validity for a specified additional period. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing. A Bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting his Bid Security. A Bidder agreeing to the request will not be required or permitted to modify his Bid, but will be required to extend the validity of his Bid Security for the period of the extension, and in compliance with Clause IB.15 in all respects.

B15 Bid Security

- Each Bidder shall furnish, as part of his Bid, a Bid Security in the amount stipulated in the Bidding Data Sheet in Pak Rupees or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency.
- The Bid Security shall be, at the option of the bidder, in the form of Deposit at Call or a Bank Guarantee issued by a Scheduled Bank in Pakistan or from a foreign bank duly counter guaranteed by a Scheduled Bank in Pakistan in favor of the Employer valid for a period 28 days beyond the Bid Validity date.
- Any Bid not accompanied by an acceptable Bid Security/Earnest money shall be rejected by the Employer as non-responsive.
- The Bid securities of unsuccessful Bidders will be returned as promptly as possible, but not later than 28 days after the expiration of the period of Bid Validity.
- The Bid Security of the successful Bidder will be returned when the Bidder has furnished the required Performance Security and signed the Agreement.
- 15.6 The Bid Security may be forfeited:
 - (a) If the bidder withdraws his bid except as provided in IB 22.1;
 - (b) If the Bidder does not accept the correction of his Bid Price pursuant to IB 27.2 hereof; or
 - (c) In the case of successful Bidder, if he fails within the specified time limit to:
 - (i) Furnish the required Performance Security, or
 - (ii) Sign the Agreement.
 - (iii) Furnish the required JV agreement within 7-days of the receipt of letter of acceptance.
- 15.7 Bidder can apply for the Contract supported with Bid security specified in bidding data.

IB.16 Alternate Proposals by Bidder

- Should any bidder consider that he can offer any advantages to the Employer by a modification to the designs, specifications or other conditions, he may, in addition to his bid to be submitted in strict compliance with the Bidding Documents, submit any Alternate Proposal(s) containing (a) relevant design calculations; (b) technical specifications; (c) proposed construction methodology; and (d) any other relevant details / conditions, provided always that the total sum entered on the Letter of Price Bid shall be that which represents complete compliance with the Bidding Documents. The technical details and financial implication involved are to be submitted in two separate sealed envelopes as to be followed in main bid proposals.
- Alternate Proposal(s), if any, of the lowest evaluated responsive bidder only may be considered by the Employer as the basis for the award of Contract to such bidder.

B.17 Pre-Bid Meeting

- The Employer may, on his own motion or at the request of any prospective Bidder(s), hold a pre-bid meeting to clarify issues and to answer any questions on matters related to the Bid Documents. The date, time and venue of pre-bid meeting, if convened, is as stipulated in the Bidding Data Sheet. All prospective Bidders or their authorized representatives shall be invited to attend such a pre-bid meeting.
- The Bidders are requested to submit questions, if any, in writing so as to reach the Employer not later than one week before the proposed pre-bid meeting.
- Minutes of the pre-bid meeting in shape of response to queries or suggestions of the bidders, including the text of the questions raised and the replies given, will be transmitted without delay to all purchasers of the Bid documents. Any modification of the Bid documents listed in IB 7.1 hereof which may become necessary as a result of the pre-bid meeting shall be made by the Employer exclusively through the issue of an Addendum pursuant to Clause IB.9 and not through the minutes of the pre-bid meeting.
- Absence at the pre-bid meeting will not be a cause for disqualification of a Bidder.

B18 Format and Signing of Bid

- Bidders are particularly directed that the amount entered on the Form of Bid shall be for performing the Contract strictly in accordance with the Bid Documents.
- 18.2 All appendices to Bid are to be properly completed and signed.
- No alteration is to be made in the Form of Bid nor in the Appendices thereto except in filling up the blanks as directed. If any such alterations be made or if these instructions be not fully complied with, the Bid may be rejected.
- 18.4 Each Bidder shall prepare by filling out the forms completely and without alterations one (1) original and number of copies, specified in the Bidding Data, of the documents comprising the Bid as described in Clause IB.7 and clearly mark them "ORIGINAL" and 'COPY" as appropriate. In the event of discrepancy between them, the original shall prevail.
- 18.5 The original and all copies of the Bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Bidder. This authorization shall consist of a written confirmation as specified in the Bidding Data Sheet and shall be attached





- the bid. The name and position held by each person signing the authorization must be typed or printed below the signature. All pages of the Bid, except for un-amended printed literature, shall be signed or initialed by the person signing the bid.
- Any amendments such as interlineations, erasures, or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by the person signing the bid.
- Bidders shall indicate in the space provided in the Letter of Technical and Price Bids, their and proper addresses at which notices may be legally served on them and to which all correspondence in connection with their bids and the Contract is to be sent.
- Bidders should retain a copy of the Bidding Documents as their file copy.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS FOR SINGLE STAGE TWO ENVELOPE PROCEDURE

Sealing and Marking of Bids

- Each Bidder shall submit his Bid as under:
 - (a) ORIGINAL and each copy of the Bid shall be separately sealed and put in separate envelopes and marked as such.
 - The envelopes containing the ORIGINAL and copies will be put in one sealed envelope and addressed / identified as given in Sub- Clause 19.2 hereof.
 - The technical bid should comprise of documents listed in IB11.1 (A) & the price bid should comprise of documents listed in IB 11.1 (B) which shall be placed in separate envelopes in accordance with IB 11.1.
- The inner and outer envelopes shall;

 - Provide a warning not to open before the time and date for bid opening, as specified in the Bidding Data Sheet.
- In addition to the identification required in IB 19.2 hereof, the inner envelope shall indicate the name and address of the Bidder to enable the Bid to be returned unopened in case it is declared "late" pursuant to Clause IB.21
- If the outer envelope is not sealed and marked as above, the Employer will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the Bid.

B20 Deadline for Submission of Bids

- Bids must be received by the Employer at the address specified no later than the time and date stipulated in the Bidding Data Sheet
 - (b) Bids with charges payable will not be accepted, nor will arrangements be undertaken to collect the Bids from any delivery point other than that specified above. Bidders



shall bear all expenses incurred in the preparation and delivery of Bids. No claims will be entertained for refund of such expenses.

- (c) Where delivery of a Bid is by mail and the Bidder wishes to receive an acknowledgment of receipt of such Bid, he shall make a request for such acknowledgment in a separate letter attached to but not included in the sealed Bid package.
- (d) Upon request, acknowledgment of receipt of Bids will be provided to those making delivery in person or by messenger.
- 20.2 The Employer may, at his discretion, extend the deadline for submission of Bids by issuing an amendment in accordance with Clause IB.9, in which case all rights and obligations of the Employer and the Bidders previously subject to the original deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

IB.21 Late Bids

- 21.1 (a) Any Bid received by the Employer after the deadline for submission of Bids prescribed in Clause IB.20 will be returned unopened to such Bidder.
 - (b) Delays in the mail, delays of person in transit, or delivery of a Bid to the wrong office shall not be accepted as an excuse for failure to deliver a Bid at the proper place and time. It shall be the Bidder's responsibility to determine the manner in which timely delivery of his Bid will be accomplished either in person, by messenger or by mail.

IB.22 Modification and Withdrawal of Bids

- 22.1 Any Bidder may modify or withdraw his Bid after Bid submission provided that written notice of the modification or withdrawal is received by the Employer prior to the deadline for submission of Bidders.
- The modification, substitution, or notice for withdrawal of any bid shall be prepared, sealed, marked and delivered in accordance with the provisions of Clause IB.19 with the outer and inner envelopes additionally marked "MODIFICATION", "SUBSTITUTION" or "WITHDRAWAL" as appropriate.
- No Bid may be modified by a Bidder after the deadline for submission of Bids except in accordance with IB 22.1 and 27.2.
- Withdrawal of a Bid during the interval between the deadline for submission of Bids and the expiration of the period of Bid validity specified in the Form of Bid may result in forfeiture of the Bid Security in pursuance to Clause IB.15.

IB.24 Process to be Confidential

Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of bid and recommendations for the award of a contract shall not be disclosed to bidders or any other person not officially concerned with such process before the announcement of bid evaluation report which shall be done at least ten (10) days prior to issue of Letter of Acceptance. The announcement to all Bidders will include table(s) comprising read out prices, discounted prices, price adjustments made, final evaluated prices and recommendations against all the bids evaluated. Any effort by a bidder to influence the Employer's processing of bids or award decisions may result in the rejection of such bidder's bid. Whereas any bidder feeling aggrieved may lodge a written complaint not later than ten (10) days after the announcement of the bid evaluation report; however mere fact of lodging a complaint shall not warrant suspension of the procurement process.

IB.25 Clarification of Bids

- 25.1 To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of Bids, the Employer may, at his discretion, ask any Bidder for clarification of his Bid, including breakdowns of unit rates. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing but no change in the price or substance of the Bid shall be sought, offered or permitted except as required to confirm the correction of arithmetic errors discovered by the Employer in the evaluation of the Bids in accordance with Clause IB.28.
- 25.2 If a Bidder does not provide clarifications of its Bid by the date and time set in the Employer's request for clarification, its bid may be rejected



Base Examination of Bids and Determination of Responsiveness

Prior to the detailed evaluation of bids, the Employer will determine whether each bid is substantially responsive to the requirements of the Bidding Documents.

A substantially responsive bid is one which (i) meets the eligibility criteria; (ii) has been properly signed; (iii) is accompanied by the required Bid Security; ; (iv) Includes signed begrity Pact where required as per clause IB.35and (v) conforms to all the terms, conditions and specifications of the Bidding Documents, without material deviation or reservation. A material deviation or reservation is one (i) which affect in any substantial way the scope, quality or performance of the Works; (ii) which limits in any substantial inconsistent with the Bidding Documents, the Employer's rights or the bidder's obligations under the Contract; (iii) adoption/rectification whereof would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantially responsive bids. Only substantially responsive bid shall be considered for further evaluation.

If a bid is not substantially responsive, it may not subsequently be made responsive by correction or withdrawal of the non-conforming material deviation or reservation. The Employer may, however, seek confirmation/clarification in writing or by email which shall be responded accordingly.

Correction of Errors

Bids determined to be substantially responsive will be checked by the Employer for any arithmetic errors. Errors will be corrected by the Employer as follows:

- (a) Where there is a discrepancy between the amounts in figures and in words, the amount in words will govern; and
- where there is a discrepancy between the unit rate and the line item total resulting from multiplying the unit rate by the quantity, the unit rate as quoted will govern, unless in the opinion of the Employer there is an obviously gross misplacement of the decimal point in the unit rate, in which case the line item total as quoted will govern and the unit rate will be corrected.
- The amount stated in the Letter of Price Bid will be adjusted by the Employer in accordance with the above procedure for the correction of errors and with the concurrence of the Bidder, shall be considered as binding upon the Bidder. If the Bidder does not accept the corrected Bid Price, his Bid will be rejected, and the Bid Security shall be forfeited in accordance with IB 15.6(b) hereof.

Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

The Employer will evaluate and compare only the Bids determined to be substantially responsive in accordance with Clause IB.26.

In evaluating the Bids, the Employer will determine for each Bid the evaluated Bid Price by adjusting the Bod Price as follows:-

(a) Making any correction for errors pursuant to Clause IB.27

(b) Excluding Provisional Sums and the provision, if any, for contingencies in the Summary Bill of Quantities, but including competitively priced Day work.



- Making an appropriate adjustment for any other acceptable variation or deviation.
- The estimated effect of the price adjustment provisions of the Conditions of Contract, applied over the period of execution of the Contract, shall not be taken into account in Bid scalazion.
- Bid of the successful Bidder is seriously unbalanced in relation to the Employer's extrate of the cost of work to be performed under the Contract, the Employer may require the Bidder to produce detailed price analyses for any or all items of the Bill of Quantities to demonstrate the internal consistency of those prices with the construction methods and schedule proposed. After evaluation of the price analyses, the Employer may require that the amount of the Performance Security set forth in IB.32 be increased at the expense of the successful Bidder to a level sufficient to protect the Employer against financial loss in the event of default of the successful Bidder under the Contract.

AWARD OF CONTRACT

B Award

- Subject to Clauses IB.30 and IB.34, the Employer will award the Contract to the bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents and who has offered the lowest evaluated Bid Price, provided that such bidder has been determined to be eligible in accordance with the provisions of Clause IB.3 and qualify pursuant to IB 29.2.
- The Employer, at any stage of the bid evaluation, having credible reasons for or *prima facie* evidence of any defect in Bidder's capacities, may require the bidders to provide information concerning their professional, technical, financial, legal or managerial competence whether already pre-qualified or not:

Provided that such qualification shall only be laid down after recording reasons in writing. They shall form part of the records of that bid evaluation report

Employer's Right to Accept any Bid and to Reject any or all Bids

Notwithstanding Clause IB.29, the Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidders or any obligation except that the grounds for rejection of all bids shall upon request be communicated to any bidder who submitted a bid, without justification of grounds. Rejection of all bids shall be notified to all bidders promptly.

1331 Notification of Award

Prior to expiration of the period of bid validity prescribed by the Employer, the Employer will notify the successful bidder in writing ("Letter of Acceptance") that his Bid has been accepted. This letter shall name the sum which the Employer will pay the Contractor in consideration of the execution and completion of the Works by the Contractor as prescribed by the Contract (hereinafter and in the Conditions of Contract called the "Contract Price").

- Negotiation with the bidder having evaluated as lowest responsive or any other bidder be permitted, however, Employer may have clarification meetings to get clarify any in the bid evaluation report.
- The notification of award and its acceptance by the bidder will constitute the formation of Contract, binding the Employer and the bidder till signing of the formal Contract Agreement.
- Upon furnishing by the successful bidder of a Performance Security, the Employer will mountly notify the other bidders that their Bids have been unsuccessful and return their bid

Performance Security

- The successful bidder shall furnish to the Employer a Performance Security in the form and amount stipulated in the Bidding Data Sheet and the Conditions of Contract within a period of 14days after the receipt of Letter of Acceptance.
- Falure of the successful bidder to comply with the requirements of IB.32.1 or IB.33 or B.35 shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the

Base Signing of Agreement

Upon furnishing of acceptable Performance Security under the Conditions of Contract, formal Agreement between the Employer and the successful bidder shall be executed.

General Performance of the Bidders

The Employer reserves the right to obtain information regarding performance of the bidders on their previously awarded contracts/works. The Employer may in case of consistent poor performance of any Bidder as reported by the employers of the previously awarded contracts, inter-alia, reject his bid and/or refer the case to the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC). Upon such reference, PEC in accordance with its rules, procedures and relevant laws of the land take such action as may be deemed appropriate under the circumstances of the case including black listing of such Bidder and debarring him from participation in future bidding for similar works.

The Successful Contractor/Joint Venture shall comply with and acquire all consents, approvals, permits and licenses applicable under the laws of Pakistan in relation to the performance of the work & services.

Integrity Pact

The Bidder shall sign and stamp the Integrity Pact provided at Appendix-L to Bid in the Bidding Documents for all Federal / Provincial Government procurement contracts exceeding Rupees ten million.

Instructions not Part of Contract

Bids shall be prepared and submitted in accordance with these Instructions which are provided to assist bidders in preparing their bids, and do not constitute part of the Bid or the Contract Documents.
